

IN AN AUTO ACCIDENT?

HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO DO.

SAFETY

Turn on your hazard lights, pull your car over to a safe place (if you can) and call 911 immediately if there are any injuries.



ALERT THE AUTHORITIES

Even if it's a minor fender bender, it's a good idea to call the authorities. Don't admit fault at this time and be sure to file an accident report.



FACT COLLECTION

Stay calm and gather this information.



EXCHANGE INFORMATION

Get names, addresses, phone numbers, license plate numbers, driver's license numbers and insurance policy number. If driving company car, jot down the business name as well.

REMEMBER:

IF YOU THINK YOU HAVE AN INSURANCE CLAIM, CALL US FIRST. WE'LL ADVISE YOU AND WALK YOU THROUGH THE PROCESS.

Photos to Take:



- Vehicles (make, model, license plates, all angles of the cars involved)
- Scene (position of the cars, skid marks, debris and traffic lights)
- Weather conditions at the time of the accident
- Injuries
